services and other "HCBS-waiver" services

Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) Teams (FACT - Forensic ACT)

Mobile psychiatrist/social worker/nurse/peer

with serious mental illness

A Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC)

A nonprofit healthcare organization that improves
the quality of life for individuals and families on
Long Island affected by **mental health** and/or
substance use disorders

Mental Health and Substance Use Counseling and Treatment (outpatient)

(ICRS - Intergrated Care and Recovery Services)

Individual, family, and group therapy; medication
management; includes detox and medication-assisted
treatment (MAT) **SAME-DAY ACCESS**

Specialized Services:

- Crisis mental health services
 - 24/7 mobile crisis team
 - Emergency crisis intervention services
 - Emergency crisis stabilization & planning
- Community Mobile Recovery Unit providing treatment
for substance use including medication assisted
treatment and peer services.
- Patient-centered treatment planning
- Care transition services in the home and community
- Evidence-Based Practices (proven effective)
- Primary care screening and monitoring
- Targeted case management
- Peer support, counseling, and family support services
- Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services: restoring
individuals' wellbeing and community functioning
- Intensive, community-based mental health care for
veterans and members of armed services.
