Our Peer Support Specialist will greet you & others with you. Peers provide support and guidance to help visitors feel more comfortable.

Clients will be asked to place personal belongings (bags, electronics, valuables, etc.) in a <u>secure locker</u>. This keeps your items secure & helps minimize distractions to ensure everyone's safety.

Please note: our Center is a therapeutic space free from alcohol, drugs, or any other addictive substances.

INITIAL PROCESS ("TRIAGE")

Each client will be seen by a nurse (RN).

Focused on your immediate wellbeing, our team may:

- Evaluate each client's medical stability on arrival
- Determine if our Center offers the best care for your needs
- Assess physical & mental health, screen for vital signs and things like acute medical concerns, intoxication or withdrawal, &/or Medication for Addiction Treatment (MAT) potential.

Based on **medical urgency**, clients may be seen out of the order in which individuals arrived.
